Information / Call for Abstract (Deadline : March 15th, 2025)

EUROCOALASH is an international conference focusing on the use of Coal Combustion Products (CCPs) in the construction industry with the aim to increase its use in European countries and the world. The conference is organised every two years in a European country to meet the needs of the different market situations. **In 2025, The EUROCOALASH conference will be hosted in Lille, France, 16-18 June 2025 and organised by the European Coal Combustion Products Association and the French Association of Ash Producers.**

The conference's theme will be « **Coal Combustion Products for Decarbonation and Circular Economy** ».

In most of the EU countries CCPs, especially coal ash, have been used for many years in cement and concrete, road construction and engineering works. Due to the large experience gained in the last years, requirements and specifications are now covered in respective product and application standards. In addition, coal ash is subject to continuous research work throughout Europe to produce new materials with better properties and performances.

The EUROCOALASH 2025 will specifically address durable, sustainable, and innovative uses of CCPs. It is now established that the use of fly ash improves the durability of concrete structures, but durability is differently assessed and discussed in European countries and the world due to various exposures and experiences. Sustainable aspects are increasingly addressed by new regulations for construction products and are now considered in all types of construction and engineering works using CCPs. As most CCPs can be used directly as a building material without any processing, their use makes a direct contribution to sustainable construction. Today, sustainability is more extensively discussed than the environmental regulations, which have to be considered for all kinds of applications. Innovative uses are mostly achieved by extensive research work by academic or industrial research.

To provide information on most recent developments for CCPs uses at EUROCOALASH 2025, this call for abstract is addressed to all parties in and outside Europe actively involved or interested in coal ash activities, from production, utilisation, regulation, as well as research.

Call for Abstract - Instruction

The following instructions are for authors intending to submit an abstract. Abstracts will be reviewed by an expert in the field of the subject matter and authors will be informed of whether the paper is or is not acceptable, whether some changes are required and whether it is being accepted for an oral or poster presentation. The following information is required :

1. The title of the paper;
2. The authors and any co-authors identity;
3. The presenter's identity if different from the author(s)
4. Contact details for the author and presenter (if applicable);
5. The abstract;
6. The type of presentation preferred, e.g. oral or poster;
7. The paper itself (after acceptance).

Format required

- a. A4; 21 cm x 29.7 cm (preferred) or 8.5" x 11" page size.
- b. Word document, WordPerfect or Acrobat PDF format. Security options should NOT be used.
- c. All margins are to be set to 2.54 cm or 1".
- d. Font to be Arial.
- e. No page numbers, headers or footers to be used.

Text required

- a. Title to be in 20 point bold format.
 - b. Authors to be in 14 point bold format. List main author first followed by co-authors. Identify the author's organisation and contact details.
 - c. Organisations are to be listed next in 12 point format.
 - d. Keywords: The word 'Keywords' should be in bold followed by the keywords in 12 point normal format.
 - d. The word 'Abstract' should be in 12 point bold format. The abstract follows in 12 point.
- Please keep the abstract to a maximum of 300 words or a single page including the above information.

If accepted for inclusion in the conference the abstract will be published on the conference website and in the conference pack booklet given to each attendee.
